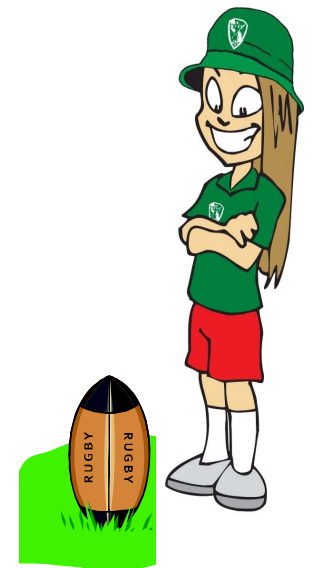

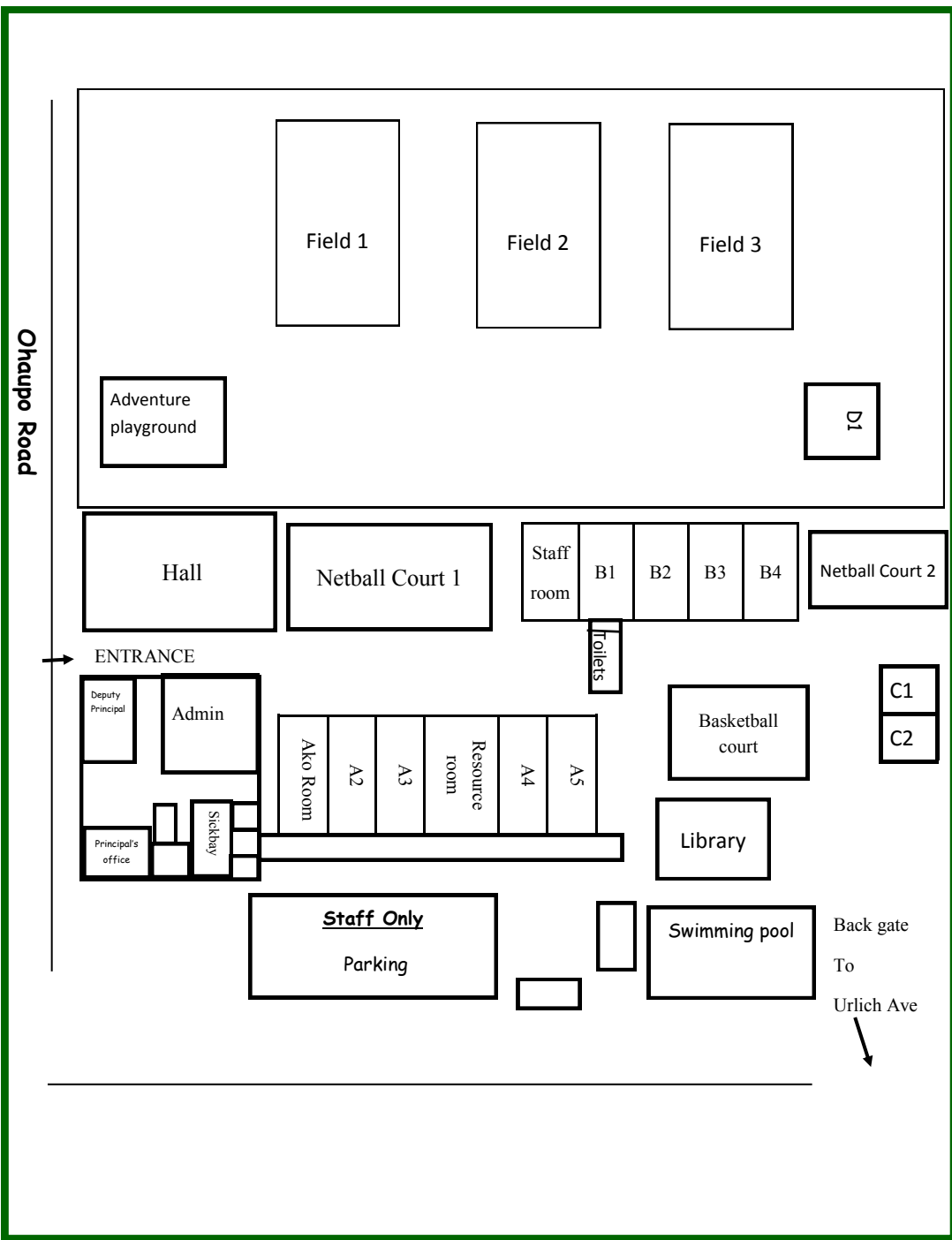

Netball Rules

1. All players must be Year 5 & 6 only
2. 7 aside Netball rules apply
3. Maximum of 10 players total in a team (incl subs)
4. Teams need to be at their court and toss done before game starts.
5. Games are 20 minutes (10 minute halves)
6. There will be a half time bell/hooter to change ends.
7. Referees decision is final.
8. Win - 3 points
Draw - 2 points
Loss - 1 point
Bonus - 1 point for 10 or more goals



Rugby 7's Rules

1. All players must be a Year 5 or Year 6
2. Teams are seven aside - 3 forwards and 4 backs,
3. 10 Players in total per team (incl subs)
4. There will be **THREE** reserves **ONLY**
5. Teams need to be at their field and toss done before game starts
6. Games are 20 minutes (10 minute halves)
7. **NO RUGBY BOOTS , MOUTHGUARDS COMPULSORY**
- No mouth guard, student will be sent from the field
8. Headgear is acceptable but no other padding
9. There will be a half time bell/hooter to change ends, no half time talks
10. There are no lineouts, if ball goes out it will be a scrum. There is no pushing in the scrum. Teams will win their own ball (all forwards to stay in scrum until ball is out)
11. Referees decision is final.
12. Win - 3 points
Draw - 2 points
Loss - 1 point
Bonus - 1 point for 5 or more tries.
12. All teams in semi and final games must stay to play the game—this is in fairness to all
